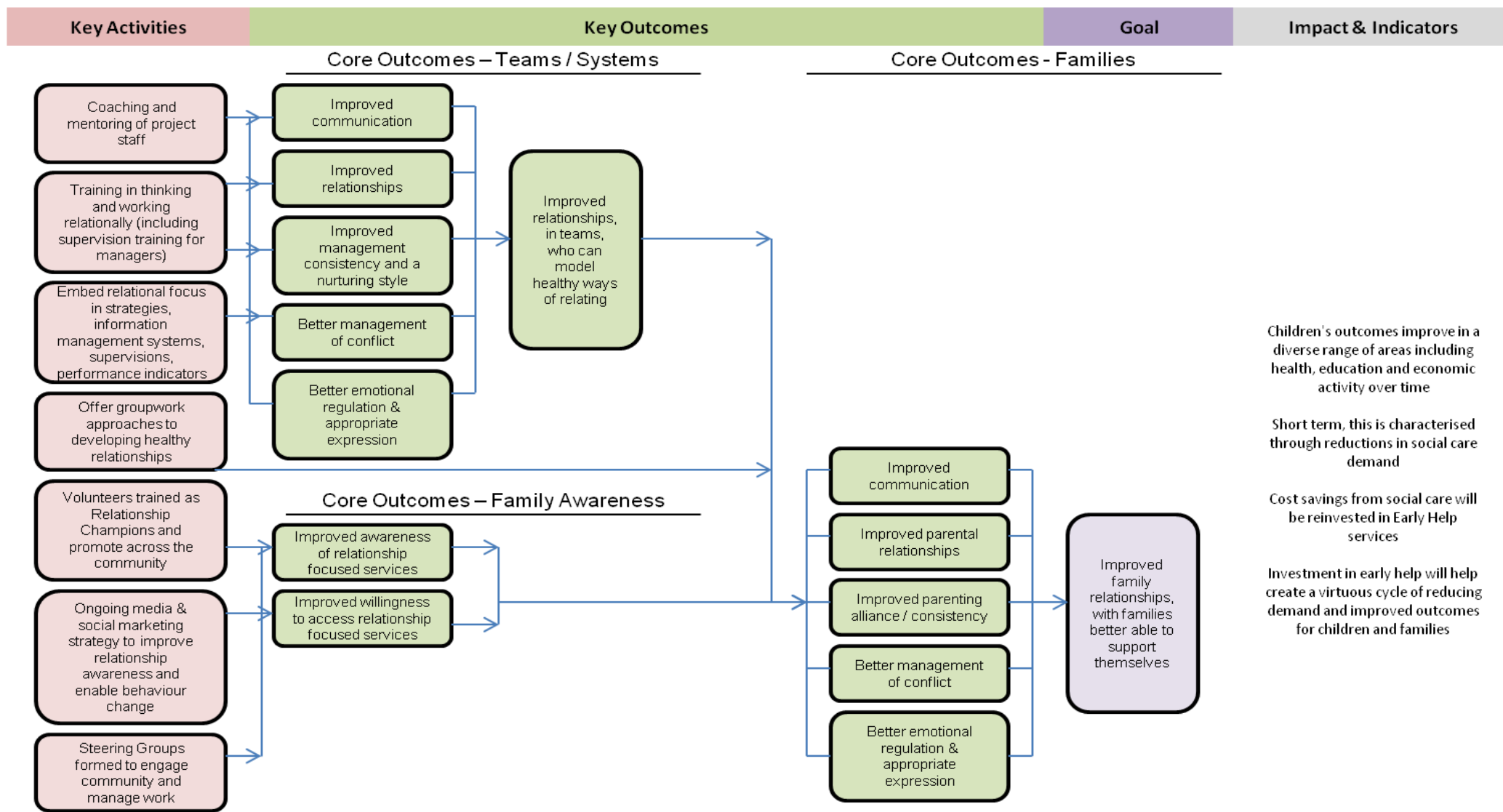


Healthy Relationships, Better Childhood, 2015 to 2020 — Theory of Change

Improved team relationships/functioning from coaching, training and strategy/systems being conducive to change – see Meichenbaum, 1993; Boreham & Morgan, 2004; Boan, 2008; Passmore, Peterson & Freire, 2012; Obholzer & Tobers, Schein) also re training see oneplusone randomised controlled trial “relationship support an early intervention programme”

Improved awareness from promotion activities and stakeholder involvement – IPPR Many to Many report, 2014; CFNE marketing impact data for separated services, 2014; local service user consultation by Parenting Commissioner, 2010
Improved relationships from a relationship & couple relationship focus - see Parents as Partners evaluation (Iieberman et al, 1991), CFNE local evaluation data of conflict resolution service, 2014; efficacy of mediation & counselling services see Bowler et al, 2011; Hill et al, 2008 etc.
